GENERAL GUIDELINES & REQUIREMENTS

Anyone age 15 or older may participate (after training, persons under age 21 will be paired with older adults for field assignments). Trail Stewards must be responsible, trainable, accountable, capable of moderate hiking. No knowledge of *Old Spanish Trail* required (training provided). Trainees to complete one two-day workshop. Maximum 25 people per workshop. Participants will be trained in trail identification concepts and use of GPS devices and other field equipment (training materials and equipment provided by OSTA). Training also provided in ‘*Leave No Trace*’ and ‘*Tread Lightly*’ principles. *Artifact collection will be strictly prohibited.* Training workshops are free; pre-registration is required. Trail Stewards must sign Federal Agency Volunteer/Hosted Worker agreement before beginning field work. Trained Trail Stewards must be or become OSTA members; first-year dues (\$25) will be waived for workshop graduates who become new OSTA members. Teams of two trained Trail Stewards will be assigned to future data collection and/or condition assessment project on specified segments of the *Old Spanish Trail* corridor, using prescribed protocol.
